Missouri Senator Karla Eslinger (Rep.) currently serves as the Majority Caucus Whip and is running for re-election to the MO State Senate to represent District 13 (Douglas, Howell, Ozark, Shannon, Stone, Taney and Texas Counties). Eslinger has previously served in the MO House of Representatives, representing District 155 from 2019-2021. This year, bills sponsored by Eslinger include MO SB51 (Modifies provision relating to physical therapists) and MO SB704 (Modifies provisions relating to applications for physician licensure). The Missouri Osteopathic Political Action Committee is in support of Eslinger's re-election campaign.
